About the Tournament:

A few years back a group of guys from the Sunday Night Pick-Up Hockey League were looking for an excuse to get together during the summer and hang out instead of waiting till winter to see each other again. A makeshift golf tournament was started as a round of golf at the local course and a potluck picnic back at one of the player's home. After one of our hockey brothers, Steve Formanek, passed away unexpectedly we thought it would be a good idea if everyone participating in the golf outing donated \$10 towards the memorial scholarship his wife set up in his name. With some very generous participants and without even breaking a sweat we were able to raise \$1,000 for The Stephen A. Formanek Memorial Scholarship Fund offering scholarships to graduating seniors from Windsor High School in Windsor, CT.

After that year we decided to turn this golf outing into a real fundraising golf tournament to be able to offer more scholarships in Steve's name. The idea behind the tournament was to get the local hockey players and families, who aren't necessarily golfers, out for a fun day in the sun while raising money for a good cause. That is when we created the annual "Old Time Hockey" Golf Tournament benefiting The Steve Formanek Memorial Scholarship. The tournament consists of a shotgun start best ball format with goodie bags and tournament tee shirts with hole sponsors and donors listed on the back. We also include a raffle ticket with each goodie bag for donated prize raffle that follows the catered late lunch/dinner after the event. 100% of the proceeds and 100% of the hole sponsorships go directly into The Steve Formanek Memorial Scholarship Fund.

This year is the 11th year of the official tournament and we have been growing ever since the start. Last year we had enough participants to close the course for the day and raise over \$6,000 for the scholarship fund to provide scholarships for the class of 2020 at Windsor High School. This year there will be three seniors whom are furthering their education through either trade school or college that will be receiving a scholarship check from The Steve Formanek Memorial Scholarship Fund or The Chris House Memorial Scholarship Fund. Since 2010, we gifted over \$52,000 in scholarships in memory of Steve Formanek and Chris House.

This year's tournament date is set for Saturday, June 19th 2021 at Airways Golf Course and Country Club in West Suffield, CT. With your help we would like this "little" tournament to continue to grow and be able to offer more scholarships in honor of a great friend. We want to continue to offer a great value to the participants to encourage friends/hockey players that are not regular golfers the opportunity to come out and play with us. We are looking for companies associated with the hockey, golf, motorcycle, construction and automotive industries as well as local business that are willing to either sponsor a hole or donate prizes for the fundraising raffle for all of our participants.
